



Preliminary Design Concept

The design seeks to maximize the space in this small park by working with the existing slope to create different 'rooms' for play and leisure while maintaining clear east-west sightlines. Trees along the paths provide much needed shade at this sunny site and a small play area has been integrated into both flat and sloped areas of the park as few playgrounds exist in the neighbourhood.

A rain garden and bioswale at the north and south ends of the park gather and infiltrate stormwater while also enhancing habitat. At the south end of the park, a wildflower meadow benefits from the southern exposure and helps to stabilize the steep slope. To provide an accessible route through the park, the main pathway curves to decrease the slope and accommodate all park visitors.
