Subject: Upcoming Bus Lane and Bus Stop Changes on 49th Avenue

Dear Resident or Business Owner,

We are writing to inform you of planned bus lane and bus stop changes on 49th Ave, and to seek your input on potential impacts to parking and loading.

In spring 2026, the City of Vancouver and TransLink plan to adjust bus stop spacing along Route 49 and add bus lanes on 49th Ave between Cambie St and Fraser St.

These improvements will:

- help buses move smoothly through traffic and stay on time.
- improve travel times and reliability for over 35,000 weekday transit trips while maintaining access to businesses.
- support Council's [direction](#) to prioritize transit on 49th Ave and eight other corridors, to achieve a 10% improvement in bus travel times and reliability.

What's Changing

Bus Lanes on 49th Avenue (Cambie St to Fraser St)

Following the completion of utility upgrades and pavement rehabilitation on 49th Ave, the curb lanes are planned to be marked as **bus lanes in both directions on 49th Ave, between Cambie St and Fraser St from 7am to 10pm, seven days a week** (see map on pg. 4).

Curbside parking would be restricted from 7am to 10pm daily and at the approaches to intersections. High occupancy vehicles (HOVs) are not permitted to travel in the bus lane.

Vehicles may enter the bus lane to make right turns when approaching an intersection or driveway.

Bus Stop Improvements

More than half the bus stops on Route 49 are spaced closer than TransLink guidelines. To make trips quicker and more reliable while maintaining transit access, changes are proposed to bus stop locations on Route 49 along 49th Ave and sections on Dunbar St and 41st Ave (see map on pg. 4).

The stops on Route 49 are proposed to change as follows:

- Reduce eastbound stops from 62 to 48 stops (15 stops cancelled, and 1 new stop)
- Reduce westbound stops from 61 to 50 stops (13 stops cancelled and 2 new stops)

Accessible landing pads will be installed at the new bus stops and three other existing stops.

Have your say – tell us about your loading and parking needs

We understand that changes to curb space may affect pick-ups, deliveries, and parking. To help reduce these impacts, we are exploring additional loading zones and time-limited parking on nearby side streets. Your input will help us better understand loading needs and consider changes to loading zones, side-street parking, or rear-lane operations.

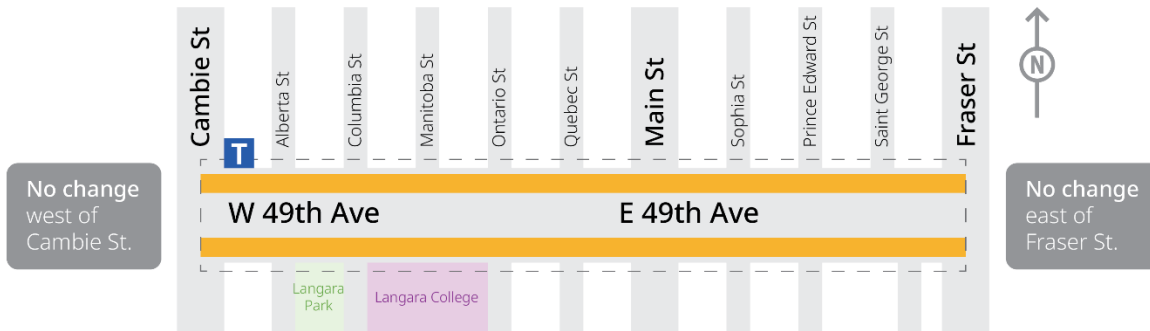

Bus lane changes on 49th Ave from Cambie St to Fraser St

7AM - 10PM, 7 days/week bus lanes

- Adding **new bus lanes** on 49th Ave between Cambie St and Fraser St.
- Existing bus lanes on the north side of 49th Ave approaching Main St **extended** from weekday AM/PM peak periods to **7AM - 10PM, 7 days a week**.
- **Parking restricted** during bus lane hours.
- Other high occupancy vehicles (HOVs) are **not permitted** to use the bus lane.
