RE: Granville Street Transit Improvements

We are writing to inform you of some upcoming transit changes on Granville Street between W 16th Avenue and SW Marine Drive.

The City of Vancouver and TransLink are relocating some bus stops and extending bus lane hours to keep buses moving smoothly (see map below). Granville Street is a busy corridor and people taking transit are often delayed. With faster bus service that stays on-time, the upgrades will improve access to destinations in Marpole Village, South Granville, and across the city.

Bus Stop Improvements

TransLink is proposing to remove 19 bus stops and add four new accessible bus stops at signalized crossings (see map below). Bus stops will be more evenly spaced, with the goal of meeting TransLink's recommended bus stop spacing guidelines of at least 300m between stops for all-day frequent routes. These changes focus on improving Route 10 and N10 along Granville Street between W 16th Ave and SW Marine Drive and will take effect **June 23, 2025**.

Bus Priority Lane Changes

Starting in fall 2025, bus priority lane hours will be extended along Granville Street (see map below). This will help to provide faster and more reliable bus service and will support people travelling in the neighbourhood. These are the proposed bus lane hours along Granville Street:

- W 16th to 63rd Ave: Existing northbound and southbound bus lanes will be extended to operate all day (24/7)
- Marpole Village (W 63rd Ave to SW Marine Drive southbound): Bus lanes will be extended to peak hours (7–10 am and 3–7 pm, Monday to Friday)
- Marpole Village (W 70th Ave to W 63rd northbound): Bus lanes will be extended to peak hours (7–10 am and 3–7 pm, Monday to Friday)
- SW Marine Drive to W 70th Ave northbound: Existing bus lanes will be extended to operate all day (24/7)

Parking and Loading

To better serve businesses, some of the existing loading zones and time-limited parking spots will be moved to nearby side streets, where possible.

- **Granville St from W 16th to 63rd Ave:** There will be no street parking on either side of Granville Street.
- Marpole Village (west side of Granville St from W 63rd Ave to SW Marine Drive): Street parking and loading will remain outside of weekday peak periods (7-10 am and 3-7 pm. There will be new parking and loading spaces at the closed bus stop at W 65th Ave outside of weekday peak periods.
- Marpole Village (east side of Granville St from W 70th Ave to W 63rd northbound): Street parking and loading will remain outside of weekday peak periods (7-10 am and 3-7 pm.
- East side of Granville St from SW Marine Drive to W 70th Ave northbound: There will be no street parking.

From **April 14 – April 24**, our team will visit businesses along Granville to share project details, discuss parking and loading needs, and determine if parking regulation changes are needed.
