**Subject: Upcoming Transit and Curbside Changes on E Hastings St from Kaslo St to Boundary Rd**

Dear Resident or Business Owner,

We are writing to inform you about some upcoming transit changes to E Hastings St between Kaslo St and Boundary Rd.

In spring 2026, the City of Vancouver and TransLink plan to extend bus lane hours to help buses move smoothly through traffic and stay on time. Hastings St is one of the busiest corridors in Vancouver, and people taking transit are frequently delayed in traffic. These upgrades will help to improve accessibility and reliability for 68,000 transit trips on Hastings every day while maintaining access to local businesses.

To help meet Council's goal of improving transit speed and reliability on Hastings and other major routes by 10%, we will make these changes in early 2026 before the FIFA World Cup. Extended bus lanes will also support the [R2 RapidBus extension](#) between the North Shore and Metrotown, launching in 2027.

**What's Changing (starting late spring 2026)**

Starting in spring 2026, bus lanes on E Hastings St are planned to be extended to 24 hours per day, 7 days per week (see map on page 3) in the following areas:

- Eastbound from Kaslo St to Boundary Rd
- Westbound from Boundary Rd to Renfrew St

As the bus lanes are implemented, parking and high occupancy vehicles (HOV) will no longer be permitted to use the curb lane.

## **Have your say – tell us about your loading and parking needs**

We understand that changes to curb space may affect pick-ups, deliveries, and parking. To help reduce these impacts, we are exploring additional loading zones and time-limited parking on nearby side streets. Your input will help us better understand loading needs and consider changes to loading zones, side-street parking, or rear-lane operations.

## **TransLink's Bus Stop Improvements**

In spring 2026, TransLink will also seek feedback on proposed bus stop changes along the Hastings corridor to improve bus travel times and reliability. The proposed changes are designed to space bus stops more evenly, typically about 300-400m between stops. These changes will affect routes 3, 8, 14, 16, 20, R5 and N35 along Hastings St between Homer St and Boundary Rd and will take effect in late 2026 following a review of the feedback on the proposed changes. All proposed changes will be posted at affected bus stops during the spring 2026 engagement period.
