RE: Pine Street Link - Connecting the Arbutus and Seaside greenways

Dear community member,

We're working to make the connection between the Arbutus and Seaside greenways (via Pine Street) safer to walk, bike, and roll. You are receiving this letter because you live or own a business along the Pine Street link.

We'd like to get your feedback on the updated design by either:

You can also learn more and provide feedback at a pop-up event at Burrard Slopes Park on Thursday, April 16, 5-7pm.

The updated design for Pine Street is based on feedback from community engagement in 2022 - 2023. We heard that people were supportive of improving safety for cycling, linking the two greenways and enhancing the public realm. We heard concerns regarding vehicle access to laneways, vehicle parking and loading, and vehicle circulation.

The updated design aims to address these concerns, while maintaining or enhancing the connection and public space.
