VANCOUVER, BC – Vancouver Mayor Ken Sim released the following statement about the recent tragic crane incident that took place at the Oakridge Park construction site:

“I am deeply saddened by the tragic news of the fatal crane incident that took place yesterday at the Oakridge Park construction site. My heartfelt condolences go out to the victim's family, friends, and colleagues who are undoubtedly experiencing immense grief during this difficult time.

“Safety is, and must remain, our top priority. I am thankful for the swift response and ongoing efforts of the Vancouver Fire Rescue Services, the Vancouver Police Department, the B.C. Coroners Service, and WorkSafeBC who are collectively leading the work onsite following this tragic incident.

“We are committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of all individuals involved in our city's construction projects, and we will continue to work diligently to prevent such tragedies in the future.

“Our thoughts and prayers are with the affected individuals and their loved ones as we navigate through this challenging time together.”
