




### **Power Kiosk Locations**

At present, 5 400 amp 3-phase Power Kiosks can be found in Northeast False Creek, situated along Pacific Blvd. 2 additional Power Kiosks can be found in Shaughnessy Park at the Crescent. These kiosks are distinguishable by their green exterior as pictured on the front page.

- Power Kiosk 1 is located at 0 Block Pacific Blvd, Easy Park Lot 152
- Power Kiosk 2 is located at 0 Block Pacific Blvd, at the border of Indigo Lot 098
- Power Kiosk 3 is located at 600 Block Pacific Blvd at the border of Indigo Lot 039
- Power Kiosk 4 is located at 900 Block Carrall Street inside Indigo Lot 457
- Power Kiosk 5 is located at the corner of Pacific Blvd and Carrall Street
- Power Kiosk 6 is located at 3300 Block the Crescent at Shaughnessy Park
- Power Kiosk 7 is located at 1300 Block the Crescent at Shaughnessy Park

## **Power Kiosk Receptacles**


The Power Kiosk has a variety of receptacles to plug into. They include:

- 5 15 Amp plugs\*
- 4 20 Amp plugs\*
- 3 Pin 60 Amp Joy receptacles\*
- 200 Amp cam-lok receptacles\*
- 400 Amp cam-lok receptacles\*

The cam-lok receptacles have both male and female connectors for ground and neutral in order to accommodate the two most common film and entertainment standard requirements.

\*Please note that the maximum total panel capacity is 400 Amps per phase. Use the digital display to ensure the combined load of all connections on a single phase does not exceed 400 Amps.

#### **User Instructions for Power Kiosk**

The power kiosks are all locked and you will need a code to access them. The code is provided to you by your Film and Special Events Officer. If you did not receive a code, please contact the Officer assigned to your permit.

#### Do not share the code with anyone outside of your production.

Once you have arrived on site and are ready to tie in, please follow these steps.

- Step 1: Enter the code provided by your Film and Special events officer into the keypad and open the door.
- Step 2: Open the left door by pulling the latch at the top downward and the bottom upward.
- Step 3: On the right side of the kiosk, there is a small hatch. Open this hatch by pulling the spring loaded pin downward. The hatch will open outward. Passing power cables through this hatch will allow the main kiosks doors to be closed during use.
- Step 4: Run your cable through the small hatch from step 3 and connect them to the receptacles safely and securely.
- Step 5: Once all your connections are made, please close both of the main doors and check to see if the kiosk is secured.
- Step 6: Once you are finished using power and wrapping up, follow steps 1 to 3 to gain access to the kiosk.
- Step 7: Once all your cables are disconnected, close the hatch on the bottom right and then close the main doors.

Note: In the event of any difficulty opening the gates around the kiosk, there is a small square portal in the fence for cables to be passed through. Please see image.
