 e.g. homeless, SROs, secondary suites

## **Cultural appropriateness**

e.g. Indigenous communities



### City of Vancouver Population, 1971-2016







### City of Vancouver: Population by Age Groups 1986-2016














### Language Trends for City of Vancouver Population



### City of Vancouver Population by Immigration Status





### Immigrants as Percentage of Total Population

### Generation Status for City of Vancouver Population







#### City of Vancouver: Selected Low Income Rates, 1996-2016





#### Median Total Income Trends in City of Vancouver, Adjusted for Inflation










# Consistently High Early Childhood Vulnerability






