Dear Community Member:

RE: Construction notice - Full closure of Raymur Avenue railway crossing

On November 12, the City of Vancouver will begin to implement a full closure of the Raymur Avenue railway crossing between East Hastings Street and East Cordova Street. The closure addresses safety concerns at the crossing and meets Transport Canada's new safety standards.

This project includes installing new barriers along the north and south side of the railway crossing, removing the bell and light warning systems, placing "Do Not Enter" signs to notify people of the closure and adjusting the sidewalk on the east side of Raymur to accommodate traffic exiting the east laneway.

After the work is complete, the Raymur Avenue railway crossing will be closed to all walking, cycling and vehicle traffic in Strathcona. Two-way vehicle traffic will continue to be allowed in both the east and west laneways.

What to expect during construction

Traffic and Access: Intermittent Road closures may occur during construction. Motorists, cyclists and pedestrians should follow signage and directions from on-site traffic control personnel and observe all traffic measures. Pedestrian access on sidewalks will be maintained, but some delays and minor disruptions will be expected. Outside of construction hours, motorist, cyclist, and pedestrian access should not be impacted.

Work Hours: Construction generally occurs from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm, Monday to Friday. Night work may occur from 9:00 pm to 5:00 am. Weekend work may be required as needed, from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm.



Noise, Dust, and Vibration: During construction, there may be noise, dust and vibration from crews and equipment. City crews will take measures to minimize these impacts.




Figure 1 – Raymur Avenue Railway Crossing Closure

The following changes will be implemented beginning on November 12:

A) Adding new barriers (in purple) along the north and south side of the railway crossing

B) Continuing to allow two-way vehicle travel on both the east and west laneways

C) Removing the bell and light warning systems D) Placing "Do Not Enter" signs to notify people that the road will be closed to approaching vehicles travelling north (at Raymur Avenue near the Hastings overpass bridge) and travelling south (at East Cordova Street and Raymur Avenue)

E) Adjusting the sidewalk on Raymur Avenue at the east laneway
