

Sunset Park Master Plan

Consultation Summary February, 2015





Questionnaire Overview

- A questionnaire was used to explore the Sunset community's values concerning Sunset Park, understand the issues and opportunities facing Sunset Park and help identify directions and priorities for park improvements for the next 10-15 years.
- The questionnaire ran from November 28 to December 15, 2014.
- A total of 114 respondents completed the questionnaire. The questionnaire was accessed in the following ways:
 - Open invitation to the general public via the Sunset Park Master Plan project page on the City of Vancouver website;
 - A paper version of the questionnaire, made available at an open house event that took place at Sunset Community Centre on November 27, 2014.

How did we reach out?

- Public consultation events were advertised in multiple forums, including:
 - Ads placed in local papers
 - Fliers were delivered to the surrounding neighbourhood (a two-block radius from Sunset Park)
 - Three signs were installed in the park
 - A display was set up in the Sunset Community Centre
 - The City worked with the Community Centre Association who advertised to its members
 - The City met with the adjacent school and put up posters at the school site
 - Messaging communicated by the City through its social media channels

Who did we hear from?

- A majority of the questionnaire respondents (68 out of 114) were residents in the neighbourhood surrounding Sunset Park (with FSAs of V5W and V5X);
- Most respondents fall into the 30-59 year age category; and,
- A majority have children in their household.





Summary of Results

• At least half of respondents are regular Sunset Park visitors, saying they visit at least one or two times a week or more often, in both the spring/summer and fall/winter seasons.



- Visiting the Sunset Park Community Centre and visiting the ice rink are the two most common activities that respondents say they do when visiting Sunset Park.
- A majority of respondents (57%) say they support the eight draft principles, while 26% say they support the draft principles but with certain changes.
 - Roughly one-in-ten respondents (12%) say they do not support the eight draft principles.
- Among the existing amenities at Sunset Park, respondents are most likely to say they would like to see the ice rink changed or improved in the future, with half who want improvements to this amenity.
 - When asked to specify what type of change they would like to see for the rink, the most common mentions include expansion of the rink, upgrading of the facility and more ice time availability.



- Almost all respondents (98%) say a children's playground is 'very' or 'somewhat' important in a future Sunset Park. Other important elements include:
 - Existing field (90%);
 - Ball court (83%); and,
 - Informal play meadow (82%).
