TRANSPORTATION

As part of the **West End Parking Strategy**, residential permit parking prices will be adjusted to market based rates. To get an exemption to the market-based prices, buy your permit before **September 1**. You can buy online, by phone, or in person at the West End Community Centre.

Also, as part of the **West End Parking Strategy**, the City will be updating parking regulations to allow off-peak parking in permit spaces and installing new parking meters in some of the 2-hour parking spaces to provide more parking availability for visitors and service providers.
