WEST END COMMUNITY PLAN IMPLEMENTATION

In the last month, several applications for new developments have been received by staff. These will provide new housing (including rental housing, social housing and housing for families) and public benefits for the community. For each application, you'll have the chance to review the proposal and share your thoughts at open houses, online or through other public engagement opportunities.

Laneway Infill

The plan identified opportunities to build ground-oriented infill housing along the West End's laneways with a focus on rental housing, particularly for families with children. Two laneway infill rental projects were approved by the Development Permit Board (DPB) in November 2014. Three more infill development applications will be considered by the Board this spring.
