

WEST END COMMUNITY PLAN PHASE 2 LAUNCH SURVEY SUMMARY

SURVEY OVERVIEW

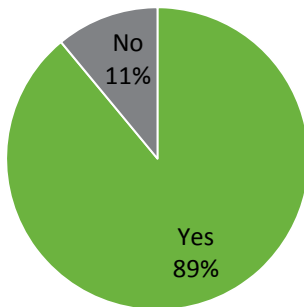
This document summarizes the responses to the survey that was conducted at the Phase 2 Launch “What We Heard” community open houses held in October 2012. The survey was also available online from October 30 to November 16, 2012. A total of 211 surveys were completed.

The purpose of the survey was to gauge support for and receive feedback regarding the:

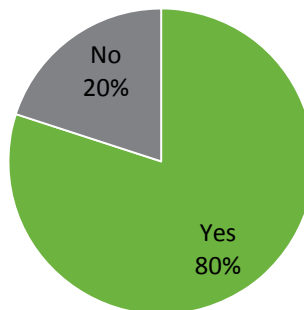
1. **Six Core Community Values** that emerged from Phase 1 consultation that will help inform directions and policy options to be developed in Phase 2;
2. **Three Lenses for Dialogue** that will provide a framework for discussions around policy options in Phase 2; and,
3. **“Action While Planning”** initiatives that took place over spring and summer 2012 around the West End community.

SUMMARY OF RESPONSES

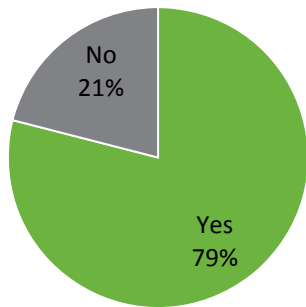
1. Do you support the six Core Community Values?



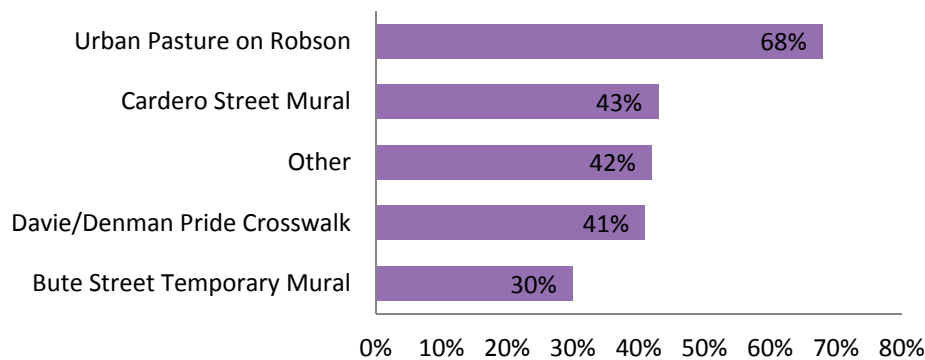
2. Do you support the ideas we heard in each of the three Lenses for Dialogue?

Most common "Other" responses:

- More permanent community gardens
- Should instead prioritize funds for maintenance/repair of streets/sidewalks (e.g. Denman St west side), etc.
- More & cleaner/nicer garbage bins
- Plant trees; ensure newly planted trees are larger
- Green Streets programs
- More benches for sitting & relaxing
- Street closures/block parties; car-free days on Denman/Davie Village
